MedPACS Announces Updates to its Vista PACS

In addition, a priority interrupt feature temporarily stops the pushed studies from being received for new studies requested (“pulled”) by the user. After the pulled studies are received, the system completes transferring the studies that were pushed.

The latest version also conveniently lists the studies contained in the archive associated with the patient currently being viewed. This provides a fast way to access all of that patient’s studies without having to sort and search the archive database.
